

Services offered by the Atlantic Veterinary College (AVC) Veterinary Teaching Hospital Behavioural Medicine Service:

The services offered are included in the table below, along with the costs and a short description of what's involved in the appointment. All prices are in Canadian currency.

For all appointments, an additional \$55 will be charged for 30 min added time during consults

For telemedicine consult – the local veterinarian is the veterinarian of record, and we ask that they fill any recommended prescriptions

As a reminder, the documents required prior to all appointments include:

- 1. Completed history form
- 2. Videos of the behaviour and living space (unless someone will get hurt)
- 3. Signed consent statement
- 4. Any relevant medical records from the family veterinarian
- 5. Proof of Rabies vaccinations if not done at AVC

"Head Start" Puppy (10 months or less) Package	\$275 for both appts – 1 hr each visit
IN PERSON	
 The point of these appointments is: to help first time dog or breed owners to prevent puppy and young dog behaviour problems and/or to address problems or potential problems as soon as they appear, rather than encouraging the client to hope that the dog will grow out of it. The point of these appointments is to helppeople who have taken rescue or shelter dogs to understand problems that these dogs commonly come with and those thatoften develop within the first few months. Prevention and early intervention are the foci. BASIC CAT APPOINTMENTS

All cat appointments (initial and recheck) will be distance consultations (via Zoom) where the local veterinarian is veterinarian of record unless there is a compelling reason not to do this. This decision is to reduce the stress and distress of the cat. In the case of compelling reasons, the cat(s) can be seen in person.

These appointments are for people who have learned they are pregnant of adopting a human baby or a young child when their first children may have fur. The intent of these appointments is to assess risk and help with adjustment to the impending arrival so that everyone is safe, and the children and furred ones have a healthy, happy relationship. "Happy Vet Visits" – IN PERSON	\$385 for all 4 appointments
Interventional package to help dogs and cats who fear or are difficult during vet appointments This intervention package is designed to assess fears, phobias, avoidance, and aggression exhibited by cats and dogs in veterinary settings. Over the course of 4 visits (one 1-hour visit where 30 minutes will be devoted to the dog's history and three 30-minute visits) dogs and cats will be assessed and a strategy maximizing kindness, fear reduction and teaching the patients how to work with the vet will be developed. Topical medication will be used. As needed, preventative, interventional, and long-term medication to redress fear and anxiety may be recommended.
